



## Slip-Resistant Properties

It is the customer's responsibility to determine the suitability of TimberTech for their particular installation - private or commercial. To assist with choice we can provide various test reports including a report for slip resistance.

### **Residential Application:**

*Should your residential decking plans include a slope, ramp or incline of any sort please be advised that when walking on this or when pushing a wheelchair or child's buggy up or down the slope additional foot purchase will be necessary as the load tends to be transferred to the sole only rather than the whole foot. To assist with extra purchase we recommend the fitting of Grit Strips to the board surface, these can be supplied by TimberTech & fitted after the deckboards have been installed.*

### **Commercial Application:**

*Should your commercial decking plans include a slope, ramp or incline of any sort please be advised that if a customer is installing a ramp/slope for public use they need to make sure themselves that the installation meets Part M regulations ("Access to and use of Buildings") which stipulate the angle of slope required and the interval for rest areas.*

### **NOTE:**

To make best use of TimberTech's slip resistance always install boards at right angles to the main direction of travel i.e. across the direction of travel
